



WHAT IS COLLECTIVE TRANSPORT?

A collective transport service offers seats in vehicles already used for other transport services (eg. adapted transport).

Thus it is a complementary service depending on availability at the moment, and does not serve door to door.

WHO CAN USE IT?

All members of the population.

HOW CAN I REGISTER?

Registration is free! Just fill out and return the registration form available at your municipal office or on the internet at www.val-saint-francois.qc.ca

HOW CAN IT BE USED?


For the moment, citizens can use places available on adapted transport vehicles. Contact Trans-Appel and reserve your seat before 3 p.m. the day before you want to travel. You will be told when and where to meet the mini-bus in your area.
