Location

The only canoe and kayak rental centre on the Saint-François River between Sherbrooke and Drummondville, this nautical pavilion is located in a wonderful park on the riverside in the heart of town, with its Victorian character.

Accessible by the cycling green path, the park has pedestrian footpaths, picnic areas, a reception chalet and a parking of 65 spaces.

The nautical pavilion is accessible by exit 88 off autoroute 55. Take route 116 towards Richmond, turn right at the second traffic lights (Craig street), and continue straight ahead until you reach Main (Principale) street. Turn left, and 500 metres further, you will find the nautical pavilion on your right, alongside the railroad track (small train station).

Activities available

Down river canoeing and kayaking **with accompanying guide** (compulsory, with the exception of those holding a valid certificate) and return in a mini-van;

Choice of two circuits: A) Richmond to Trenholm (about 2 hours)
B) Windsor to Richmond (about 5 hours)

If the river flow is not suitable for a safe journey, the trip will take place at the *Marais de Kingsbury* (10 km from the site)

Picnic tables and pedestrian footpaths *sentier des Orties*;
Free access to the nautical pavilion, park and parking

1) For the 5-hours expedition, plan lunch at half-course. Departure from Richmond at 9h30 (shuttle towards Windsor). Minimum of 8 persons..

3) The family package is limited to a maximum of 2 canoes or kayaks.

Schedule and supervision

Open without reservation:

Saturdays and Sundays, after June 24 to Labour Day

Open with reservation:

Monday to Friday, after June 24 to Labour Day
(8 persons minimum)

Schedule for departures:

A) Trenholm's Circuit: 12h00 & 15h30
B) Windsor's Circuit: 9h30

Note: All participants must arrive 45 minutes before departure to try equipment and learn the basics.

Safety: For safety reasons, the nautical pavilion offers only down river journeys with accompanying guides when the river flow is adequate. However, on presentation of appropriate certificates accepted by the *Fédération de canot kayak du Québec* (or equivalent), the users can rent the equipment and leave without guides.
